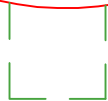

# WP-1816 Christmas Tree 2 by OTB Patterns

Use this pattern to create a simple wall or door hanging, or other decor.

Suggested materials: 1/4" or 1/2" Baltic Birch Plywood, solid lumber, colored acrylics, or plexiglass.

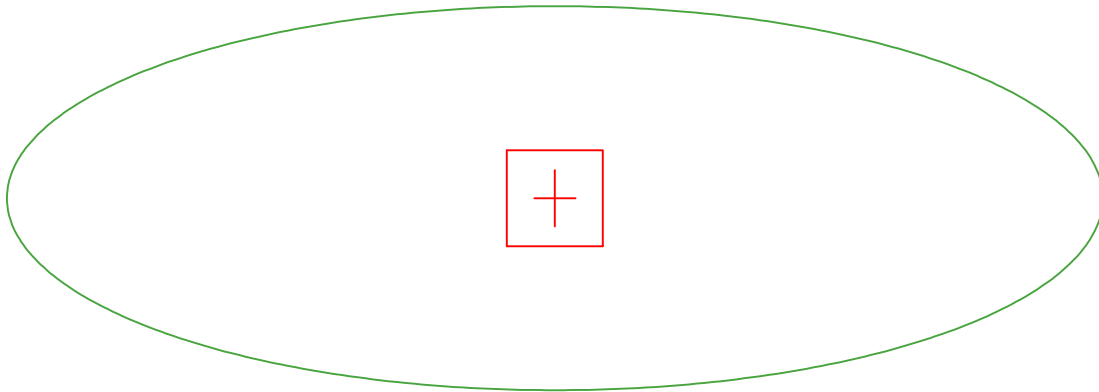
Suggestions:

1. Cut tree out using outline only, Use pattern to paint areas different colors.

2. Cut each area out of different colored hardwoods, then glue pieces together after staining or painting.

After cutting, trim all edges with razor knife and sand with 150 grit sandpaper. Stain or paint your item. Finish with clear sealer.

Add small metal hanger to back if desired. OR, cut trunk at broken line on bottom to slip into a base.



Use one of these base layouts or a base layout from another pattern. (WP-1810 on Religious page will work.) Remember to adjust cut-out size on base to match your material thickness.
