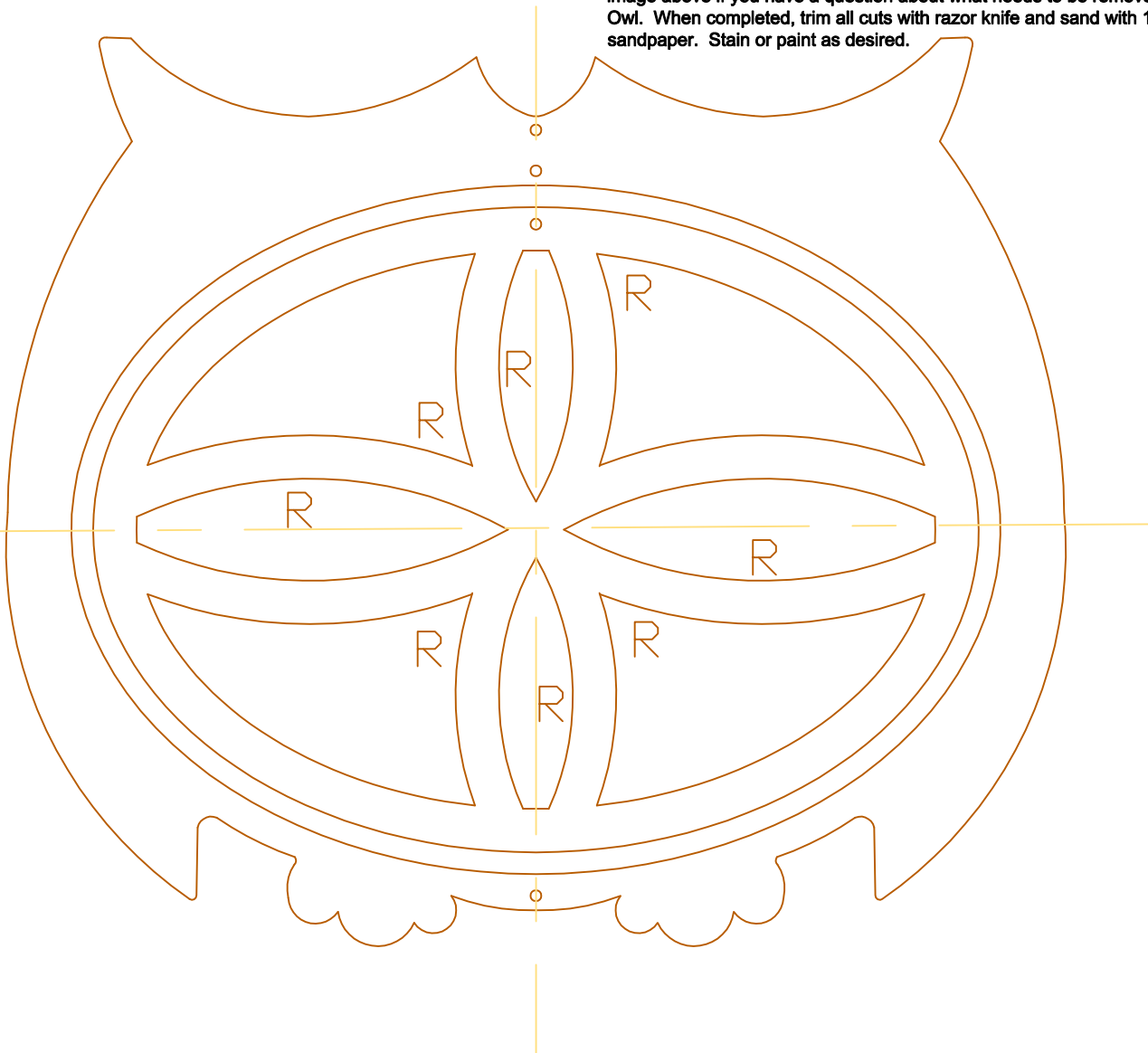
## WP-1820 HANGING OWL PATTERN by OTB Patterns.



Note: This pattern is made up of eight separate pieces and with each piece hung with fishline. Adjust hole placement as required to get just the right balance for you.

1. Start with a piece of material, or several different pieces using different wood species for different parts so they may be stained differently. Or, Cut Belly piece out of colored plexiglass or acrylic.

2. Drill 1/16" dia. hole at or near where holes are shown on plan. Also drill your holes as necessary for inserting blade for cutting interior cutouts. See image above if you have a question about what needs to be removed from your Owl. When completed, trim all cuts with razor knife and sand with 150 grit sandpaper. Stain or paint as desired.
